Fondue	<p>This event was a get together where BMEs had cheese fondue. It took place in the recreational room in the student village in ETH Höngg campus. The cheese was ordered and the caquelon sets were rented from Barmettler Molkerei in Stans. Two of the BMEs volunteered to pick-up the cheese and go to Aligro for the rest of the shopping. VSETH's mobility account was used to book a car. Students were charged 16CHF each, the rest of the expenses were covered through our budget of 2018. We are making an effort to turn this into an annual fondue dinner event. Spring Semester Welcome Event	<p>A simple beer & pizza get together similar to the new-comers welcome event is being organized to reflect on the past exam period and talk about plans for the spring semester and summer. This was not done before. Additionally, the participation in the skiing event would have been higher if it were not delayed into the immediate weekend before the spring semester began (where everyone was still out of Zurich).
